

Core Bus Corridors Swords to City Centre



There has been a lot of thinking and work on the best routes for bus corridors.

These are known as Emerging Preferred Routes.



One route goes from Swords to the City Centre. This bus corridor will start at the Swords Road at the Pinnock Hill junction.



It will go along the Swords Road, Drumcondra Road and Dorset Street.

The bus will then travel on North Frederick Street and Parnell Square East.



The bus corridor will join the bus lanes in the City Centre.



Now, the bus journey from Swords to the City Centre takes over 70 minutes.

With the bus corridor, this journey will take up to 40 minutes.



The route is 12 kilometres.



There will be new cycle lanes along this route.



We need to make changes along the route to make room for the bus corridor.

For example, changing the road layouts, taking down and replacing some trees, taking away parking spaces, making changes to some gardens.
