Tá an dara Babhta Comhairliúcháin Phoiblí ar siúl anois

le haghaidh Chonairí Iompair Inbhuanaithe Chorcaí

Is é BusConnects Chorcaí an togra ón Údarás Náisiúnta Iompair a bhfuil mar aidhm leis **11 Chonair Iompair Inbhuanaithe nua** a sholáthar do Chorcaigh. Soláthróidh sé sin:



Trí BusConnects Chorcaí, tá an tÚdarás Náisiúnta Iompair ag infheistiú €600m i dtodhchaí inbhuanaithe do Chorcaigh chun tacú le fás na cathrach san fhiche bliain romhainn agus chun ár n-oibleagáidí aeráide a chomhlíonadh.

Rachaidh na conairí iompair inbhuanaithe nua chun tairbhe don chathair ar na dóigheanna seo a leanas:

- gréasán iompair phoiblí níos éifeachtúla a chruthú
- freastal níos fearr ar riachtanais gach úsáideora bóithre
- agaí turais bus a laghdú agus iontaofacht a fheabhsú
- cathair níos inbhuanaithe níos inchónaithe a chruthú agus do choisithe
- timpeallacht níos sábháilte a chruthú do rothaithe

Le linn mhí an Mheithimh 2022, chuir BusConnects Chorcaí tús leis an gcéad bhabhta comhairliúcháin phoiblí. Sa chomhairliúchán 13 seachtaine, fuair an tÚdarás Náisiúnta Iompair trí mhíle aighneacht.

The 2nd Round of Public Consultation is now underway for Cork's Sustainable Transport Corridors (STCs)

BusConnects Cork is the National Transport Authority's (NTA) proposals to deliver **11 new Sustainable Transport Corridors (STCs)** for Cork. This will deliver:



Through BusConnects Cork the NTA is investing €600m in a sustainable future to support the city's growth over the coming two decades and meet our climate obligations. The new sustainable transport corridors will benefit the city in the following ways:

- create a more efficient public transport network
- reduce bus journey times and improve reliability
- create a safer environment for cyclists and pedestrians
- better serve the needs of all road users
- create a more sustainable and liveable city

In June 2022, BusConnects Cork commenced its first round of public consultation. The 13 week consultation led to three thousand submissions being received by the NTA.

YOU SPOKE AND WE LISTENED.

Based on your feedback last year, the NTA has made a number of revisions to its initial proposals. One of the main changes to note is that we are now proposing **11 schemes instead of 12 STCs**. Sunday's Well to Hollyhill STC is no longer being progressed as an individual scheme, with sections of the corridor being incorporated into adjacent schemes.

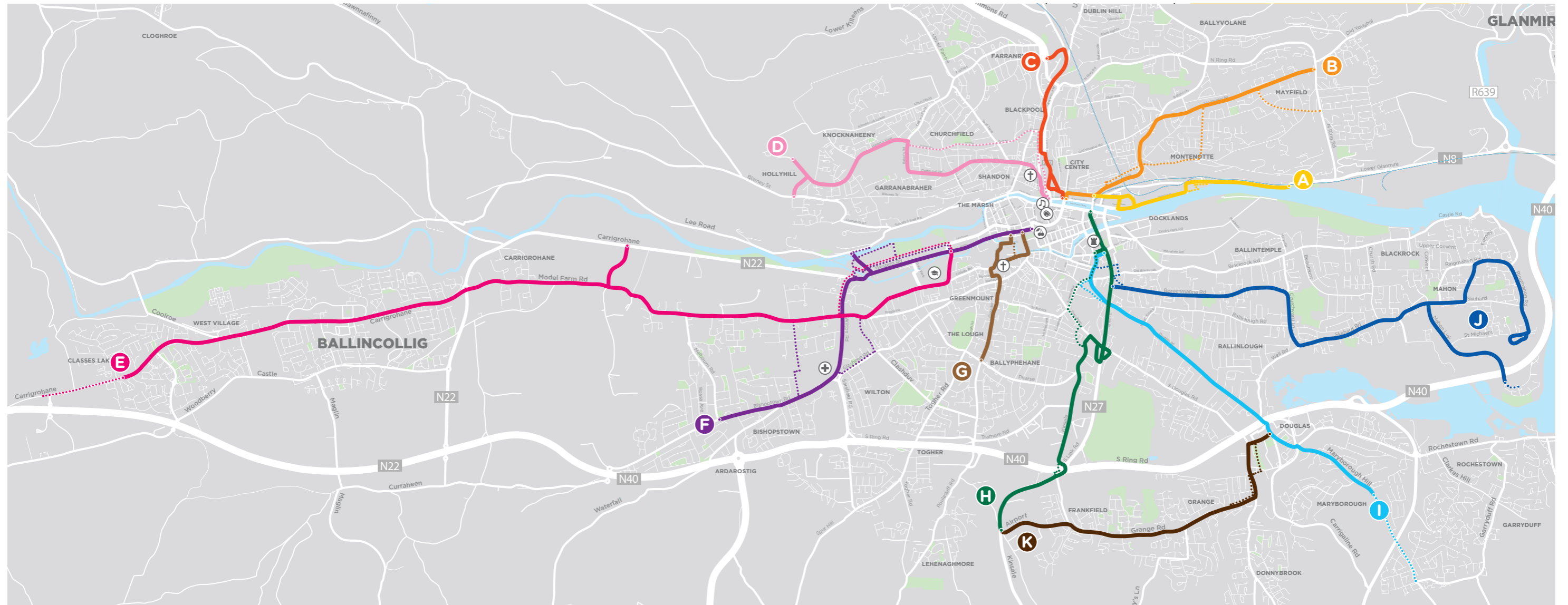
