

ABP Tallaght/Clondalkin to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme Status Update/Note to be issued to Public Reps & Community Forum Members 04.05.2023

Dear Public Representative/ Community Forum Member,

We are emailing you to provide a status update in relation to the Core Bus Corridors.

This week, the National Transport Authority (NTA) gave notice of its application under Section 51(2) of the Roads Act 1993 (as amended) to An Bord Pleanála for approval in relation to a proposed road development consisting of the construction of the **Tallaght/Clondalkin to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme**.

For information, a small number of changes have been made to this scheme following consideration of the submissions received during the third round of public consultation (at the end of 2020) and these are summarised below.

- New sustainable link road (bus and active travel) between Birchview Avenue/Treepark Road and Parkview/Greenhills Road;
- Two pedestrian/cyclist bridges over M50;
- Greenhills Road – outbound bus lane omitted to avoid building demolition;
- Offline cycle tracks added to Kildare Road;
- Bangor Drive & Clonard Road made one way;
- South Circular Road junction revised to align with DCC Dolphin's Barn Public realm Improvement Scheme;
- Winetavern Street junction revised to align with DCC one-way bus lane;
- Pedestrian/cyclist ramps and bridges at Naas Road junction refined.

Submissions/observations on this scheme may be made in writing to the Board at **An Bord Pleanála (Strategic Infrastructure Division), 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, D01 V902** between **Tuesday 9th May 2023 and Tuesday 4th July 2023**.

Any submissions/observations must be accompanied by a fee of €50 and must be received by the Board not later than **5.30 p.m. on the 4th July 2023**. This fee will not apply to certain prescribed bodies including those specified in Section 51(3)(b) of the Roads Act 1993 (as amended) or to landowners and others with a legal interest in land who are objecting to compulsory acquisition of land in which they have such an interest in a compulsory acquisition case.

It is our intention to submit the schemes on a phased basis with the next two schemes likely to be submitted in the order shown below:

- Swords to City Centre CBC Scheme;
- Kimmage to City Centre CBC Scheme;

As each scheme is submitted for approval to An Bord Pleanála, the process of public notifications in newspapers and online will be repeated.
